- **ELIGIBILITY**

This competition is open to all high school students living in the state of Washington. All sculpture must use metal as the primary material. Jewelry may include alternative materials. Pieces will be considered as either Jewelry or Sculpture. Wall pieces must be ready to hang. Work made from kits is not allowed, only original artwork will be considered. No licensed images may be used. All artwork must have been created within the 2008-09 academic year in the high school classroom. **There is a limit of five entries per school, one entry per student. Sculptures must be no larger than 18” by 18” and a maximum weight of 30lbs.**

- **APPLICATION PROCESS**

A separate entry form and artist statement must accompany each piece. Artwork, entry forms and artist statements may be hand-delivered or shipped via UPS (with return shipping included) to North Seattle Community College Gallery. This is a juried competition with Jurors to be announced.

Prizes will be awarded to students for first, second, third places, and three honorable mentions, in each of the two categories - Jewelry and Metal Sculpture/Holloware.
