Directions to SAFECO Jackson Street Center:

From I-5 North:

Take the Dearborn Exit and make a right onto Dearborn Ave., turn left onto Rainier Ave. Go straight for approximately one quarter mile, then make a right onto Jackson St. Turn left on 23rd Ave. S., passing Starbucks and Hollywood Video; continue straight for one-eighth mile and turn right onto Main Street.

From I-5 South:

Take the Dearborn Exit and make a left onto Rainier Ave. Follow directions above.

From I-90:

Take the Rainier Ave. N. Exit, go straight for one-quarter mile. Follow directions above.
